You can now *rapidly execute non-exclusive, free-of-charge licences* for your IP using the dedicated non-commercial site **COVID-19 e-licensing**.

This site is being made available by UCLB to the TTOs of universities and selected research and governmental institutions across the world.

The project is part of UCLB's contribution to the humanitarian efforts to pro-actively and rapidly disseminate COVID-19 technologies globally.

UCLB offers free hosting and licensing of IP meeting the following criteria:

- **Fully developed**, ready to be licensed.
- Licences can be time-limited but **must be free of charge**.
- Submitted by institution's **TTO only**.
